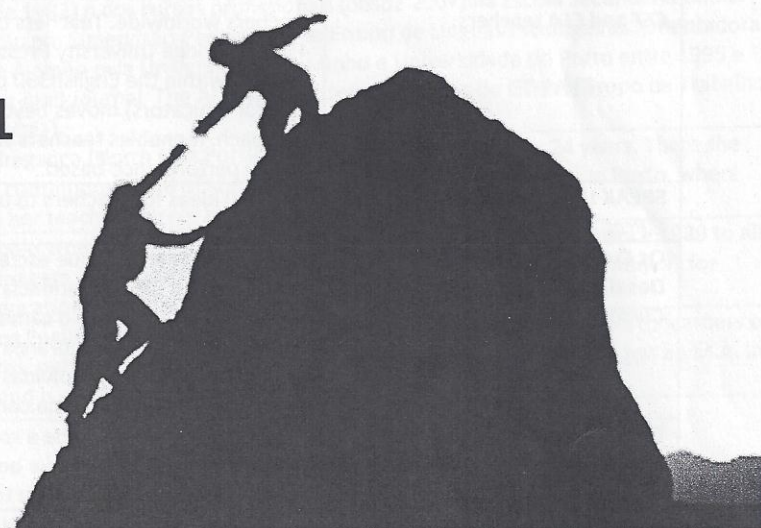

Let's CEF – Create, Engage and Follow Up! – Celeste Simões – CEF teachers.	Simple things you can do to motivate your CEF students: <u>create</u> motivational activities that <u>engage</u> students in their learning process and <u>follow up</u> with hands-on experiences.
Ensino Profissional e Desenvolvimento Pessoal e Profissional dos Professores de Inglês – Elsa Correia – Cursos Profissionais, CEF and EFA teachers.	Os docentes que leccionam Inglês a cursos profissionalizantes do sistema educativo, por vezes inesperadamente, vêem-se na necessidade de dar resposta às tarefas comuns a todos os professores – preparação e organização das aprendizagens, gestão da relação pedagógica com os alunos, promoção do seu desenvolvimento pessoal e cívico, avaliação das aprendizagens – acrescidas da especificidade que os respectivos cursos implicam. Pretende-se, nesta sessão, apresentar propostas de resposta a necessidades manifestadas e incluir o debate de diversas modalidades de formação. Haverá lugar, igualmente, a curtas actividades, práticas de autodiagnóstico e contributo para a elaboração dos Planos de Formação das Escolas e Agrupamentos, numa perspectiva de desenvolvimento pessoal e profissional do docente.
Motivating classroom activities – Emília Gonçalves – Cursos Profissionais and CEF teachers.	This session is mainly aimed at presenting a number of motivating classroom activities that may help create and sustain motivation in the classroom. From films to songs and the use of IT resources, we will explore practical activities that are more likely to engage everyone in the classroom.
Karaoke – The Pleasure of Singing as a Learning Skill - Filomena Cristo – EFA teachers.	My presentation provides teachers with a sequence of motivating ways to use karaoke as a learning strategy that helps students to improve their English skills at all levels. Karaoke in class – a tip to help students profit from a series of strategies of learning they can use after classes.
Teaching Business English with Digital Technologies – Javier González – Cursos Profissionais, CEF and EFA teachers.	[...] With English360 www.english360.com a whole new approach to materials development and course design is now available. This method involves mixing and matching material from learners, authentic web resources, mp3 or pdf files, and other shared resources from teachers worldwide. Teachers can also integrate their own course material seamlessly with 45+ Cambridge University Press titles that have recently been repurposed for online/blended delivery within the English360 platform. This new generation of content creation (which is free for educators) moves beyond the traditional book, photocopier or scissors-and-glue approach. It enables teachers to create tailor-made activities that are uniquely relevant (real-world) performance-based.
SPEAK UP! – Lucy Bravo – C.Prof., CEF and EFA teachers.	Practical ideas for teachers to use with adult groups to practise speaking skills at a variety of levels.
Os Cursos Profissionais – Novos Desafios – Madalena Proença – Cursos Profissionais teachers.	Com base nos artigos que escrevi para The APPI Journal, Spring Issue 2010 e Autumn Issue 2010, partilho uma experiência profissional e pessoal com alunos dos cursos profissionais, nível III, na qual mostro o caminho que percorri desde as primeiras resistências, passando por um sentimento de insegurança até à aceitação dos novos desafios. Neste âmbito, apresento as metodologias desenvolvidas e o tipo de avaliações mais privilegiadas para que os alunos se empenhem activamente na construção da sua aprendizagem.

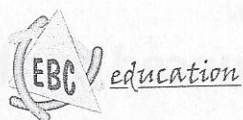

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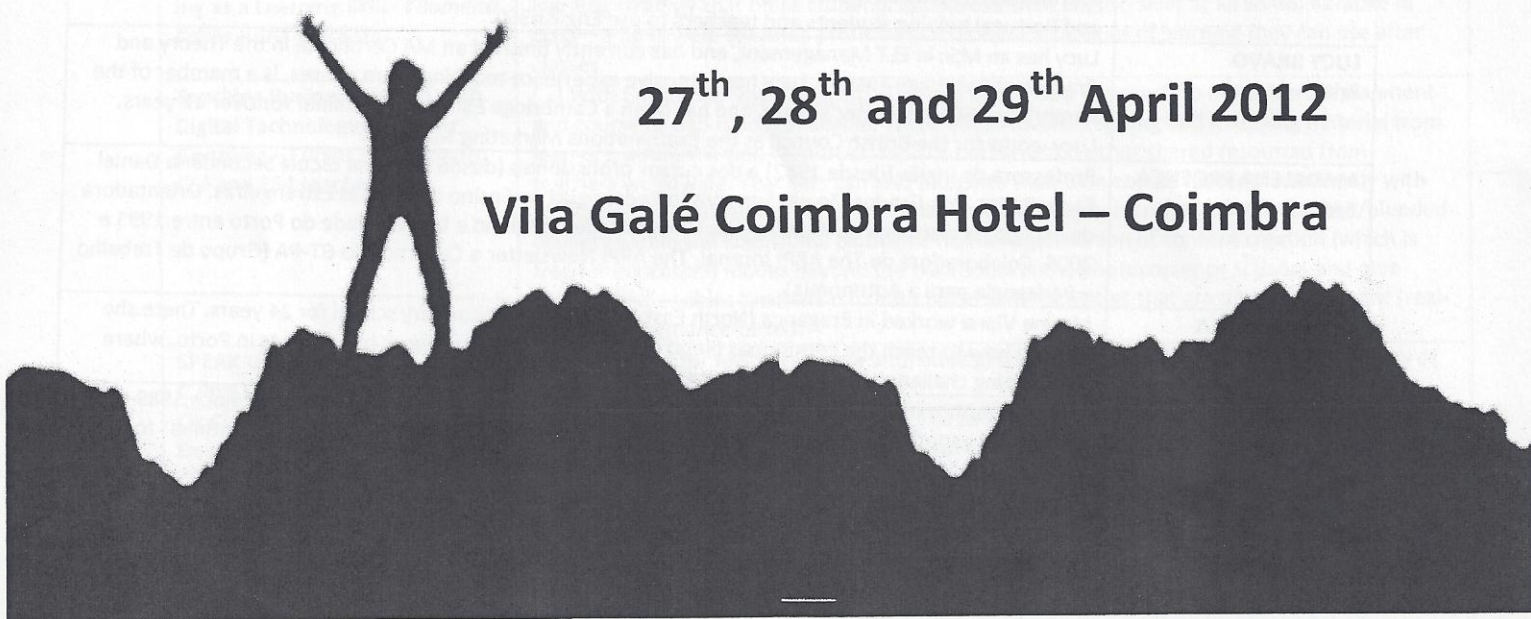
