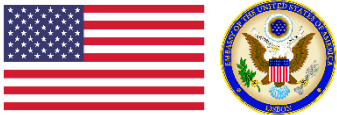

Teaching Writing in the 21st Century

Recent developments in education and technology call for us to update our approaches to teaching language effectively. Using the example of an intermediate course in writing, we will discuss and consider the new challenges and opportunities that EFL educators now face. Topics include ways of promoting effective student use of AI tools, AI-assisted approaches to collaborative storytelling, and new ways of supporting students' individual writing processes. In addition, we will revisit time-tested components of the typical language classroom to consider their ongoing importance in light of other transformations to our overall educational landscape.



Dr. Christopher Stillwell's teacher education projects around the world focus on such topics as AI in education, TESOL certificate instruction, and English as Medium of Instruction. His first edited volume on Language Teaching Insights from Other Fields was shortlisted for an ELTon Award for Innovation in Teacher Resources.
